Located on the main concourse of the Campus Center. Open 9:00 am-5:00 pm.

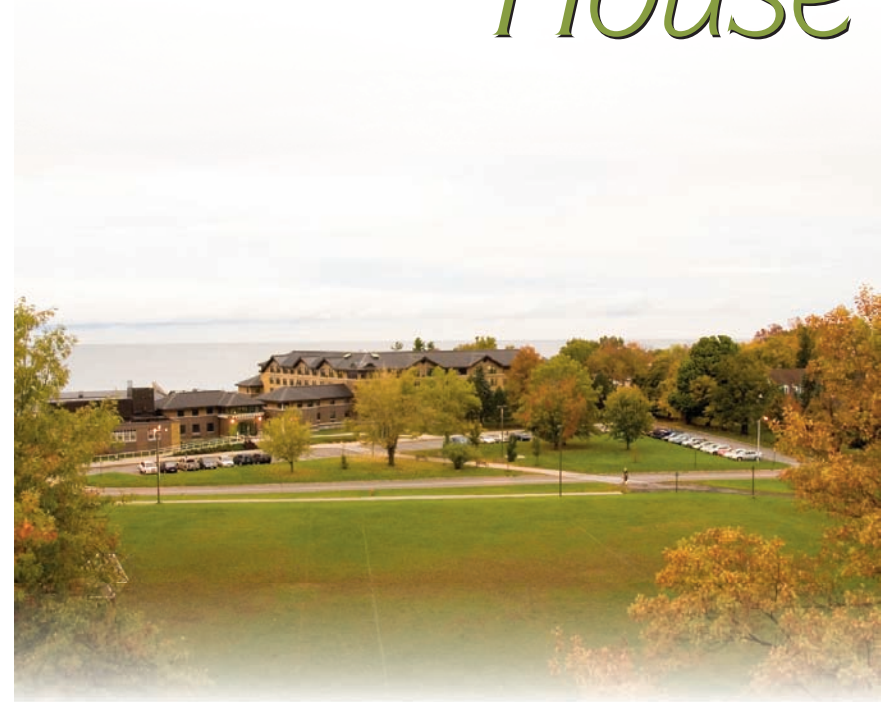
